With reference to your app'n recd here the 13th inst., we have to inform you that as you omitted to give the names of A.D.'s parents no satisfactory search could be made in the CR's of 1851. "Glennia" could not be identified as the name of a CR in Co. Clare, but the Town & Twp of Ballyvaghan were searched and a family of Murty & Mary Baily was found ^{married in 1842} with sons Martin (7 years) Michl. (4 years) & John (9 months). No son Patrick was found on the Return. The Returns for the adjoining CR's of Gleninagh ^{in the adjoining Parish of Gleninagh} were also searched and two families of Baily found one of which had a son Patt who would be much too old to be the person for whose age you are seeking. Enclosed please find a bespeak docket which you are to fill up & return with a M.D. for 2/6 to this Dept.
