Jane + William was found in
the C.R. of 1841 for Freshford
otherwise Aghow (which is
possibly the Rahua mentioned
in the letter) which is a few
miles from Uelingford, and
in the barony of Crannagh,
adjacent to that of Galmoy,
Co. Kilkenny.*

*In the C.R. for 1851 this family
had become scattered, only
a daughter Catherine remaining
at home, and the father
William having died in 1847.
No mention of a child Maggie
was found, or of any family
of Wm + Mary Butler.*

*It would be as well to
apply to the local clergy-
man at Freshford, Co
Kilkenny for a certificate
of baptism.*
