village or hamlet in which the applicant
was living in that year.

We have already searched the tld
of Leckee & found no trace of your mother's
family. They must then have been living
in some other townland - possibly
near bye. This is the information
which we want.

Possibly your mother can
remember where she went to
School & when. We might find
her in the School Returns of
1851. In any case, we
have no Census Returns of 1851 and so
the information as to her place of
residence must be exact for
that year.
