Search has been made in the CRs of 1851 for the C.R. of St John's and the family of Edward & Ellen Gurry has been found with children Patrick, Bridget, James, Margaret & Mary.

A cert copy of this return will be sent to you on receipt of a m.o. for 4/11.

Search has also been made in the CRs of 1851 & 1841 for the family of Patrick Luby and although families of that name were found there was not sufficient evidence to show they related to the one of which Ellen Luby was a member. In the

CRs of 1821, however, a family of Patrick & Ellen Luby was found with children John, Ellen & Catherine. Ellen's age is given as 13 years and as her age is put down as 40 years in the CRs of 1851 there is a strong probability that this is the correct return. A cert
