The various tults in parish of Ballylanceen have been searched in the 1821 Census. In the townland of Seafield a family of Bridget Whelan, with children Michael & Cathie, and another family of Pat & Bridget Whelan with children John, Joe, Pat, and Mary, were found, but no trace of Geffery was ascertained in either. In the townland of Carrickcastle a family of Michael Phelan described as farmer and miller was found, but the wife's name is given as Margaret, with children Mary & Edward, but no trace of Geffery. Another family in Ballylanceen tult gives a Bridget Phelan described as Aunt living with Patrick and Hannah Phelan but no children are recorded as being of Geffery in Carrickcastle.
