 Your letter of Jan 15th has been received. The Census Returns of 1821 & 1841 are preserved and contain very full information as to the number & names & ages of the members in each household. The Returns of 1831 give only the names of heads of families, but not of the members.
 You will see by enclosed Respeak docket that for purposes of Census enumeration, each County is subdivided into Barones, Parishes & Townlands. It would be advisable for you to make searching enquiries before filling this up.
 Balbriggan lies in the Parish of Balrothery, Barony of Balrothery East & County of Dublin. In the same parish is a tld called Knock. The Census Returns 1841 for this tld have been searched but no trace of Coyle family has been found. ^{Coney Hill has not been identified as a tld.}
 It is essential that you state the ^{exact} name of the tld where the family was living at the time of the Census 1821 or '41.
 The ~~cost~~ ^{charge} you should forward ~~and~~ M.O. for 4/7 to cover cost of copy of search is successful. It will be refunded if the family is not found. W.S. 10. 2. 76.
