There are no Records in this Office which might assist in proving the age of Ellen Roche. As you will have seen from enclosed circular re Proof of Age in Ireland, ^{enclosed in our letter of the 29th ult.} compulsory Regⁿ of Birth began only in 1864 so it is impossible to obtain a Certificate of a birth before that date. The ~~Census~~ Returns of the Census taken in 1851 are the latest available for search. The last paragraph of the Circular ~~will~~ explain why.
