Dear Sir,

We examined the Census Returns of 1851 for the Townland of Derry-Cassan, in the Parish of Templeport, Barony of Tullyhaw, Co. Cavan, with reference to the case of the applicant Mary McGinn, and enclose copy of the entry which we found. We also examined the 1851 Census Returns for the Townland of Toberlyan, in the same Parish and Barony with reference to the case of the applicant Terrence Kellagher, and enclose copy of the entry which we found. As both these searches were in the same Parish we had not to pay a different stamp duty Fee for each, and as the one stamp duty fee sufficed, we now return you stamps value 1/- the balance of the money which we received from you.
